- ★ Barbados is a tiny 166.4 square miles in size with a population of 285,000 people. It is possible to drive around the whole circumference of the island in about 3 hours.
- ★ Cricket is the country's national sport and local Bajans are obsessed. Barbados has produced some of the world's greatest cricketing legends.



- ★ Barbados not only produces the world's oldest rum, but it also produces one of the best. Mount Gay Rum dates back to 1703 and today is sold in over 110 countries worldwide.
- There are 270 bird species in Barbados!
 Of the 270, only one is endemic, 17 were introduced by humans, and 178 are considered rare or accidental!
